Works completed or ongoing. May 2020

Fianar

- We have 65 homeless street children from Fianar in school 4 days a week and they get a lunch and we provided clothes, books and equipment and a trip to Ranomafana.
- We are feeding 135 kids at Sr Odettes primary school in Fianar for 15 months

- We have 7 specially bright kids in boarding school or getting extra tuition
 - We installed 200 school desks in the last year
 - We supplied computer, raincoats, money for a party and 3 years tuition fees for 10 University students to the end of 2021.

- We have a well completed at a village for 11 homeless families.



New well completed in April 2020

- We have a new repaired toilet block, well head and steps installed at St Josephs and added more equipment to the carpentry shop.

- We completed paving and drainage at St Josephs. Outside seating.
- We have supplied electricity to the school and Noro's house.
- We just sent £4,000 to help with clean water for Covid 19 response
- We have a Livelihoods, food, passports and birth certs program ongoing

Tanjomoha and Schools

- The repair works at Andasy are all but completed.
- The 3 bridges to Nohona are completed to a high standard

- The new road is all but completed from the Matitanana road to Nohona.
- The foundations and main timber frame are installed at Nohona and the latrine is dug. Work stopped for now but adequate funds to complete.
- We issued 40 bikes to teachers and support the wages for 3 teachers.

- Pere has completed renovations to a new guest room for visiting teachers.
- Major upgrade at St Pauls school as above with new toilet block and new gate.
- Pere has added 4 toilets and better windows to the rear of the boys dorms
- We have a new oven using way less wood and new vents at all stoves in Tanjomoha.
- Pere has installed 3 No Solar powered hot water units for physio rooms and treatment centres and his accommodation block.
- We supported Pere to finish the road and main entrance to Tanjomoha.
- Pere visited Ireland in the summer of 2019 and left with €1,000 in cash for his mission.
- The kids from behind the wall (now 27) are fed and in school in Farafangana.
